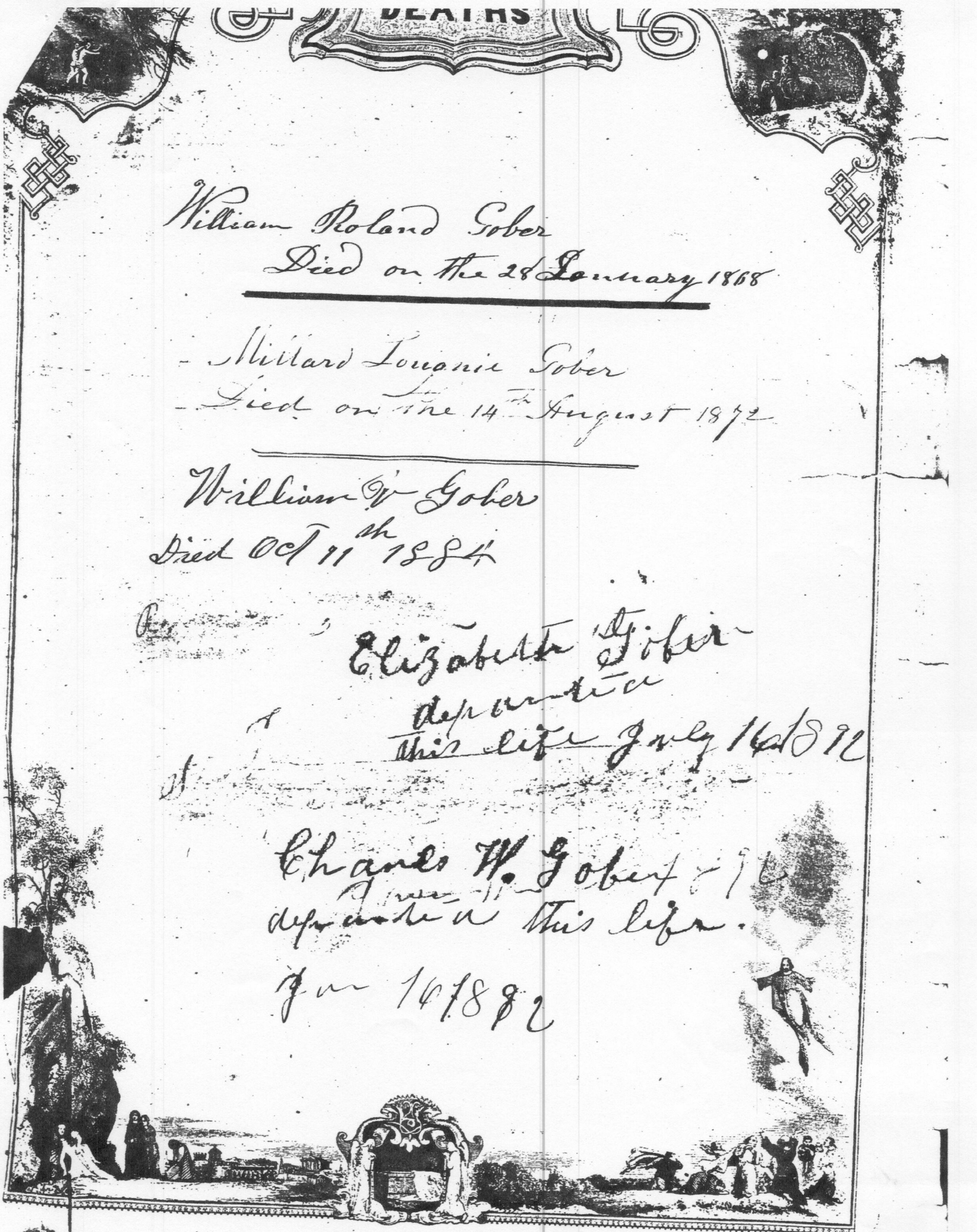

Your Gober web site is excellent and I enjoyed using it. Enclosed are some Bible records that I think you will find interesting. They are copies from my first cousin once removed. He told me I could share the Bible records with you. I am not a Gober descendant.

I think the information will clear up some data for you.

On James Gober notice that he is sometimes James Marion and sometimes James Francis. I feel reasonable certain that he was named for General Francis Marion of SC Revolutionary fame.

One of the main pieces of information is that Susan/Sudie E is a Baker the daughter of Rev Jesse S Baker and Lavina (Gober) Baker and Susan/Sudie E. married James Francis Marion Gober. So she was daughter of Gober and also married a Gober. I have not tried to work out the relationship. She is a widow on the 1900 census of Bastrop Co TX on page 147A ED 8 Sheet 1.

Elizabeth Gober, the widow of William Vincent Gober is on the 1870 census of Drew Co ARK age 74 living with Benjamin Gober. According to the Bible record she died in 1892.
