According to an old bible record from (my husband's grandmother's bible) Jessie L. Gober married Mary A (Austin?)
Gober 17 Jan 1843. Jessie L. Gober b 5 Mar 1814 d 12 Aug 1863.

I would guess that he married in Ga., because Bob's grandmother,
Orilia Parthena Gober k was supposed to have been born in Marmetta,
Cobb CO. GA. 17 Dec 1857. Family tradition says that she was a babe in arms when her family came to Texas.

Orilia was one of six children . I have not done a f great deal of research on them yet. ( It is 50 miles to the nearest library with the microfilmed census . Also the reader there is down and hasn't been repaired yet . )

My husband's mother died with TB in 1933 and was buried on his 4th birthday and his father died two years later from cancer. Bob was raised by an older sister. They lost all touch with the rest of the family. So far I have been unable to make contact with anyone.
