THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO  
 ST. MATTHEW.

CHAPTER I.

The genealogy of Jesus Christ.  
 1 THE book of the generation of Jesus Christ,  
 the son of David, the son of Abraham.  
 2 Abraham begat Isaac; Isaac begat  
 Jacob; and Jacob begat Judah and his brethren.  
 3 And Judah begat Pharez and Zerah; of  
 Pharez begat Hezron; and Hezron begat  
 Ram; and Ram begat Boaz; and Boaz begat  
 Obed; and Obed begat Jesse.  
 4 And Jesse begat David the king; and David  
 begat Solomon; and Solomon begat Roboam;  
 and Roboam begat Abiam; and Abiam begat  
 Asa; and Asa begat Josaphat; and Josaphat  
 begat Jehoram; and Jehoram begat Ozias;  
 and Ozias begat Joatham; and Joatham  
 begat Achaz; and Achaz begat Ezechias;  
 and Ezechias begat Manasses; and Manasses  
 begat Josias; and Josias begat Jechonias;  
 and Jechonias begat Salathiel; and Salathiel  
 begat Zerobabel.  
 13 And Zerobabel begat Abiud; and Abiud  
 begat Eliakim; and Eliakim begat Azor;  
 and Azor begat Sadoch; and Sadoch begat  
 Achin; and Achin begat Eliud.  
 15 And Eliud begat Eleazar; and Eleazar  
 begat Matthan; and Matthan begat Jacob.  
 16 And Jacob begat Joseph the husband of  
 Mary; of whom was born Jesus, who is called  
 Christ.  
 17 So all the generations from Abraham to  
 David are sixteen generations; and from  
 David until the carrying away into Babylon  
 are fourteen generations; and from the carrying  
 away into Babylon unto Christ are four-  
 teen generations.  
 18 Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on  
 this wise: When as his mother Mary was  
 espoused to Joseph, before they came to-  
 gether, she was found with child of the Holy  
 Ghost.  
 19 Then Joseph her husband, being a just  
 man, and not willing to make her a public  
 example, was minded to put her away secretly.  
 20 But while he thought on these things, be-  
 hold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him  
 in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David,  
 fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for  
 thus which is conceived in her is of the Holy  
 Ghost.  
 21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou  
 shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save  
 his people from their sins.  
 22 Now all this was done, that it might be  
 fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the  
 prophet, saying,

23 Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and  
 shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his  
 name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is,  
 God with us.  
 24 Then Joseph being raised from sleep did  
 as the angel of the Lord had bidden him, and  
 took unto him his wife.  
 25 And knew her not till she had brought  
 forth her firstborn son; and he called his  
 name JESUS.

CHAPTER II.

The wise men from the east.  
 NOW when Jesus was born in Bethlehem  
 of Judah in the days of Herod the king,  
 behold, there came wise men from the east  
 to Jerusalem, saying,  
 2 Where is he that is born King of the  
 Jews? for we have seen his star in the  
 east, and are come to worship him.  
 3 When Herod the king had heard these  
 things, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem  
 with him.  
 4 And when he had gathered all the chief  
 priests and scribes of the people together, he  
 demanded of them where Christ should be  
 born.  
 5 And they said unto him, In Bethlehem of  
 Judaea: for thus it is written by the prophet,  
 6 And thou Bethlehem, in the land of  
 Judah, art not the least among the towns of  
 Judah: for out of thee shall come a governor,  
 that shall rule thy people Israel.  
 7 Then Herod, when he had privately called  
 the wise men, inquired of them diligently,  
 what time the star appeared.  
 8 And he sent them to Bethlehem, and said,  
 Go and search diligently for the young child,  
 and when ye have found him, bring me word  
 again, that I may come and worship him also.  
 9 When they had heard the king, they de-  
 parted: but when they saw the star, they re-  
 joiced exceedingly.  
 10 And when they were come into the town,  
 they sought for the young child.  
 11 And when they had found him, they re-  
 joiced, and worshipped him, and presented  
 unto him gifts, gold, and frankincense, and  
 myrrer.  
 12 And being warned of God in a dream that  
 they should not return to Herod, they de-  
 parted into their own country another way.  
 13 ¶ And when they were departed, be-  
 hold, the angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph,  
 saying, Arise, and take the young child,  
 and his mother, and flee into Egypt:  
 and be thou there until I bring thee word:  
 for Herod will seek the young child to  
 destroy him.  
 14 When he arose, he took the young child  
 and his mother by night, and departed into  
 Egypt.  
 15 And was there until the death of Herod:  
 that it might be fulfilled, which was spoken  
 of the Lord by the prophet, saying, Out of  
 Egypt have I called my son.
